In accordance with our CC&R's, only annual flowers are allowed to be planted on the Association property. Many of the plants included on this list are categorized as perennial or annual depending upon where the plants are grown. To be in compliance with our CC&R's, all plants planted in the community garden plots will be treated as annuals and removed at the end of the first season that they are planted. There has been a huge influx of hybrids, varieties, species and cultivars within each genus that are now available in the nursery industry so, where applicable, those species, hybrids, varieties and cultivars will be acceptable plants to plant unless otherwise noted.
